



2022 Scholarship Application and Instructions

Submission Deadline: September 23, 2022

The Puerto Rican Bar Association Scholarship Fund, Inc. (“Scholarship Fund”) is now accepting applications for its annual scholarship. The Scholarship Fund was established to promote diversity within the legal profession by providing scholarships to Puerto Rican and Latino students attending ABA-accredited law schools. Applicants must be enrolled during the 2022-2023 academic year and must demonstrate financial hardship.

This year we will be awarding scholarships to be used for the legal education of applicants who demonstrate the following:

- Academic Excellence
- Community Involvement
- Commitment to Diversity and Inclusion within the Legal Profession
- Financial Need
- **In order to be eligible for the Scholarship, applicant must demonstrate one of the following connections to NY:**
- Resident of the State of New York.
- Enrolled in an ABA Accredited New York State Law School.
- Confirmed commitment to work in New York State after completing their law school education.
- Confirmed commitment to continued involvement with the Puerto Rican Bar Association.

Application Requirements

Applicants must submit all of the following to the Scholarship Committee by September 23, 2022:

- Cover letter describing how their academic, personal, and professional accomplishments qualify them to receive a scholarship award.
- Completed 2022 Scholarship Application.
- Resume.
- Most recent transcript (*note: students entering their 1L year must submit transcripts from their undergraduate institution or most recent post-graduate institution*).
- Class registration or other proof of enrollment for the 2021-2022 academic year.
- Essay: Applicants must submit a legal commentary from **one** of the following **four** topics (2,000 words or less): Your selected essay must cite case law, statute, rule of law, or ordinance you reasonably believe supports your legal commentary.
 1. Should federal agents be allowed to arrest and deport an undocumented person when the individual has appeared in any court for any reason?
 2. Should discovery of an individual's social media accounts and/or social media posts, including third-party subpoenas to social media companies, be permissible in any civil litigation?
 3. Does a reasonable expectation of privacy exist in an individual's social media accounts and/ or social media posts requiring a search warrant in a criminal case?
 4. Problems often endure for lack of comprehensive solutions. Present your comprehensive and well thought out solution to the United States of America's



immigration system. Include any change you propose to make to existing immigration statutes, policies and/or procedures to achieve the required balance between order, security and justice?

- Two letters of recommendation from any of the following:
 - Dean, Associate Dean, or Professor at Applicant's law school (*note: students entering their first year of law school may submit a recommendation from a Dean, Associate Dean, or Professor from their undergraduate or post-graduate institution*);
 - Member of the Puerto Rican Bar Association who is in good standing;
 - An individual who is personally acquainted with the applicant, but not related by blood, marriage, or adoption; or
 - A former employer of the applicant.
- Proof of Financial Need.

Submission Deadline

Completed applications must be **received by September 23, 2022**. Scholarship recipients will be notified by October 14, 2022 and will be honored by the Puerto Rican Bar Association Scholarship Fund, Inc. at its Annual Scholarship Award Ceremony in December 2022.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered by the Scholarship Committee. All applications, essays, and required materials must be submitted in a single PDF document to Angelicque M. Moreno at president-elect@prbany.com
